How do you sign up?

- Visit www.facebook.com and click on "Register" to get started.
- Fill in your name, email address and birthday.
- Check your email. A confirmation will arrive with a link to confirm your email. If you don't see it right away, check your spam or junk mail folder.
- Set up your profile. Fill in as much detail as possible on your profile so people can find you easily.

How do you search for friends or join groups?

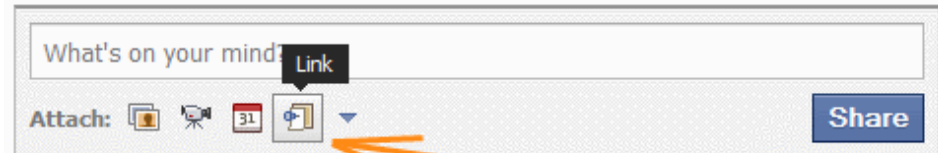
- Perform a search for friends by putting in keywords to the search box. You can search by your hometown, high school, college, or any other organization or group. Or you can search by name.
- To join a group, search for the groups name in the search box. Your search results will allow you to view each page before you join or you can join without viewing the group.

Features-Using the “What’s on your mind?” bar

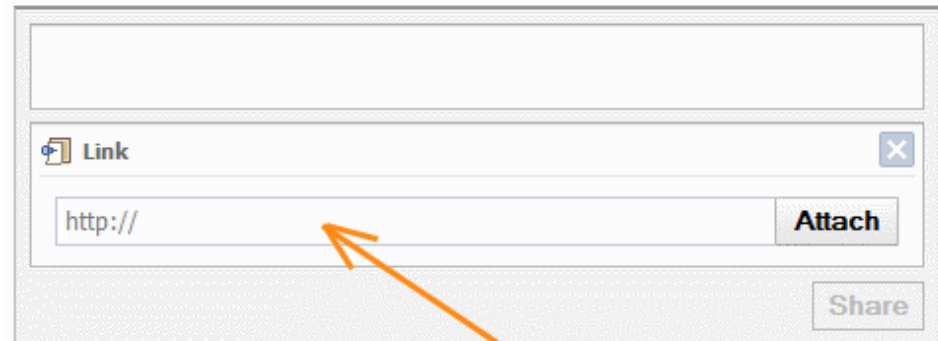
The “What’s on your mind?” bar, which you generally use for posting status updates to Facebook, can be used for posting links and sharing information with your friends (pictures, events, video).

Click on the icon you want to use and follow the simple instructions for posting either pictures, videos, links, etc. After successful attachment, you can click on the Share button to share the link with your friends. This information has now been posted to your “wall.”

When you post something to your wall it will show up in your friends News Feed. This is a great way to keep your friends engaged in what’s important to you.

Features-Sharing posts and events



If you see posts on the wall from groups or your friends sites that you would like to post to your own profile, select “share” under the post to share this post to your wall.

This is an excellent way to share events, posts, links, pictures, videos or other information with people who are not members of a certain group, but are “friends” with you.

When you select the share option, you can also add a note before you post it to your wall. You also have the option of sending the post as a message instead. This works great for events because you can invite all of your friends to attend events even if they are not a member of the group.

Once any post appears on your wall, friends can now comment on it, “like” it, or share it by posting it on their wall.
